- Don't click on links from unknown senders in emails, texts, or social media. Even if it appears to be from someone you know—check before clicking.
- Links in unexpected messages may be "phishing" attempts that aim to trick you into revealing personal information.
- Remember, scammers try to pressure you into acting quickly. Take your time—don't be rushed into anything.
