## **CYBER SECURITY TIPS**

## Don't Open Unexpected Attachments

- Avoid opening attachments unless you know and trust the sender—and were expecting the file.
   Attachments can carry harmful software (malware) that can damage your device or steal information.
- If an attachment seems unusual, reach out to the sender directly before opening it.
- Scammers may also create fake accounts that look like people you know. Verify with your friend before accepting new friend requests from someone familiar.
